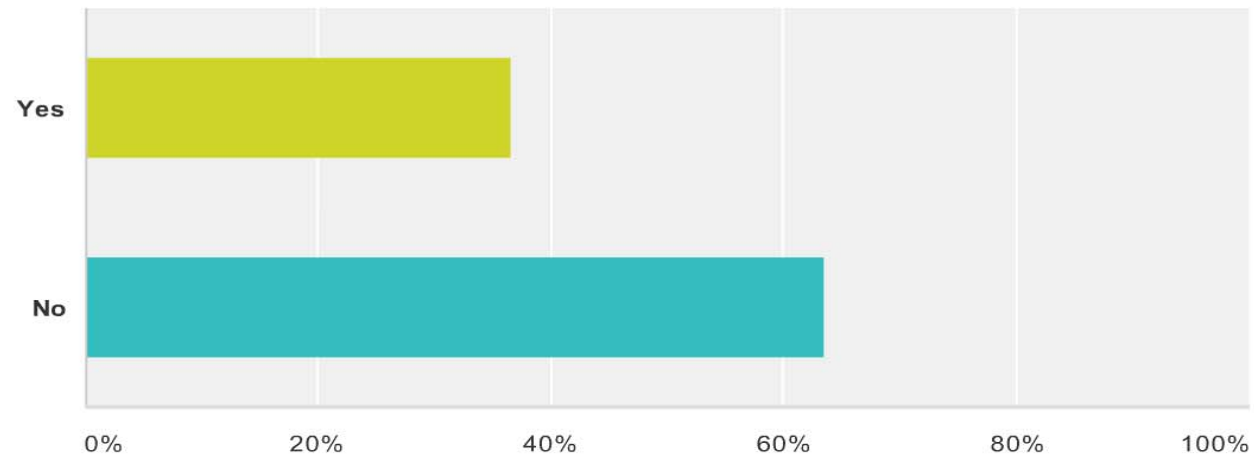

# SO THEN, WHAT IS QEP?

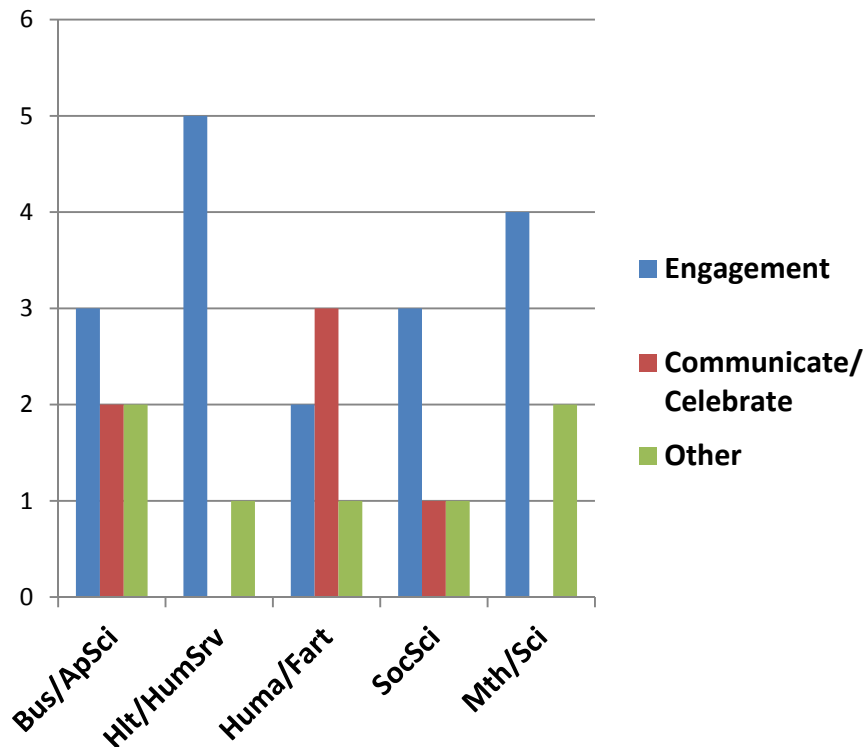
- The Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS) stipulates that accreditation requires institutional commitment to *Quality Enhancement* through continuous assessment and improvement.
- As the 2nd of two institutional reaffirmation documents, the Quality Enhancement Plan (QEP):
  - Identifies key issues emerging from *assessment* data
  - Focuses on student learning & the institutional mission
  - Includes broad-based organizational involvement throughout the development & implementation processes.

# Emergent ideas- Where we are at?

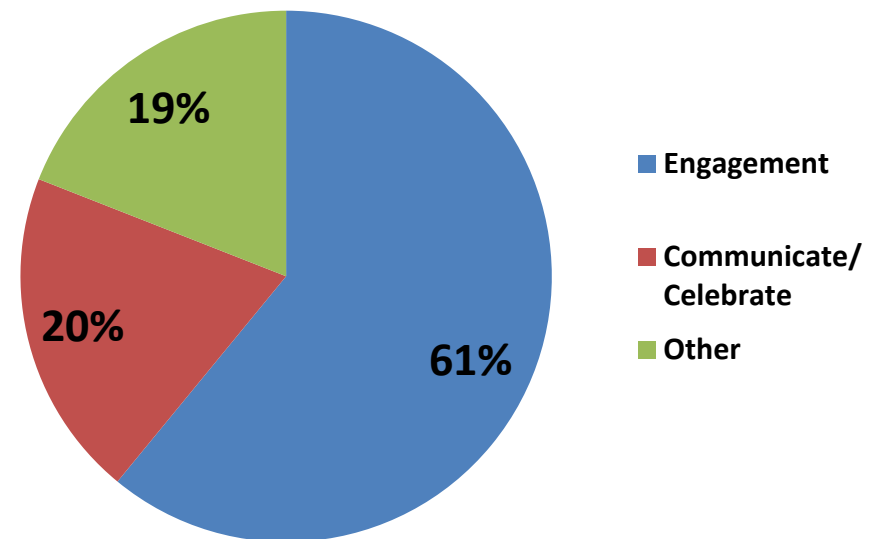
## Emergent Themes from QEP Divisional Breakout Sessions

*Two themes have emerged from these workshops consistently:*

- 1. Instituting system of tracking and monitoring student engagement (to include early identification, conferencing and mentor collaboration partnering faculty and SSCs)**
- 2. Celebrating/Communicating Markers of Excellence (to include campus activities tied to recognizing success & increased web page presence)**
- 3. Other: Includes various other recommendation that do not fit either as a separate theme or into the existing theme.**
